CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: SERBIA SCHOLARSHIPS 2022/2023

The Government of Serbia has offered **Ten (10)** for the year 2022/2023 under the program **The World in Serbia**" Project.

Interested candidates should have:

Undergraduate

- i. Minimum KCSE Mean Grade of B (plain;)
- ii. Below the age of 21 years;
- iii. Strong grades in the major subjects that are key to the preferred specialty;
- iv. Completed Secondary Education in the last three (3) years;
- v. Has KCSE original certificate.

Masters

- i. Below the age of 25 years old;
- ii. Hold at least 2nd class Honours (Upper Division);

PhD

- i. Below the age of 35 years;
- ii. Hold a relevant master's degree from a recognized University

The scholarship **covers the following**;

- i. Preparatory classes of Serbian (online course and intensive Serbian language course after the arrival in the Republic of Serbia);
- ii. Tuition fee in the field of study (Undergraduate, Graduate and PhD);
- iii. A monthly stipend of RSD 15,000;
- iv. Accommodation and food in student standard institutions;
- v. Compulsory health insurance;
- vi. Residential visa;
- vii. Verification of secondary and higher education certificates.

The scholarship **does not include**;

- i. Air travel to and from Serbia;
- ii. Local travel in Serbia; and
- iii. Costs of textbooks and work resources during the studies.

NB:

While the monthly stipend may cover some of the expenses that are not catered for by the scholarship, students are advised to organize for additional funds for expenses that they may incur.

Documents to be submitted with the application form include;

- i. Curriculum vitae with a motivational letter in English or Serbia;
- ii. **Candidates for undergraduate studies**: Certified copy of KCSE Certificate;
- iii. **Candidates for Master's Studies**: Certified copy of Undergraduate degree certificate;
- iv. **Candidates for doctoral studies**: Certified copy of undergraduate and master's certificates;
- v. Photocopy of travel document (passport);
- vi. A passport Photograph
- vii. Proof of knowledge of the English or Serbia;
- viii. Medical certificate not older than six months which confirms that the candidate does not suffer from any infectious disease; and
 - ix. HIV negative certificate
