MAURITIUS – AFRICA SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (MASS) 2026

The Government of the Republic of Mauritius is offering **Fifteen (15)** scholarships to Kenyan students at **Undergraduate**, **Masters**, **and Doctoral** levels for the 2026 academic intake. The scholarships are tenable in various universities in Mauritius.

The Scholarship will support successful candidates in meeting their tuition fees and contributing to their living expenses during their studies in Mauritius. Furthermore, the scholarship covers return airfare by the most economical route. This will be valid for travel from the country of origin at the beginning of the studies and back to the country of origin upon successful completion of studies

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should meet the following conditions:

Undergraduate

- 1. Minimum KCSE Mean Grade of B (plain)
- 2. Not more than 25 years of age
- 3. Strong grades in major subjects relevant to the preferred programme
- 4. Completed Secondary Education in the last three (3) years
- 5. Have an original KCSE Certificate

Postgraduate / Masters and PhD

- 1. Completed two (2) years of continuous public/ private service since their last degree studies
- 2. Graduated with a Bachelor's degree of at least Upper Second Class Honours for Masters
- 3. Have a Masters degree for PhD

4. Are 35 years and below for Masters and not more than 40 years for PhD programme

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

All eligible candidates must read and follow the following guidelines strictly:

- 1. Applicants are required to **apply electronically** by filling the official application form available at https://tertiaryeducation.govmu.org/te/index.php/mass/ before printing.
- 2. Obtain **Standard Application Forms** from the **Ministry of Education**, **Kenya** offices at **Telposta Towers**, **27th Floor**, **Room 2702**. The forms can also be downloaded from the Ministry's website: www.education.go.ke.
- 3. Completed two (2) copies of the online application form, certified photocopies of birth certificate and ID, certified copies of academic/professional certificates, transcripts, evidence of application for enrolment in a public HEI in Mauritius, and other testimonials should be sent to:

- 4. The Application forms should reach the Ministry not later than 23rd February, 2026.
- 5. Only shortlisted applicants (who shall be informed through e-mail or phone call) shall be invited for interview.
