SECURITY TIPS FOR KyUC STUDENTS'

- 1. Security is a personal initiative. It starts with the individual.
- 2. Whenever possible never walk alone. Consider a buddy group as central to your security.
- 3. Always let your friends know your whereabouts. Let them know your residence.
- 4. Dedicate yourself to your studies and avoid risky side businesses.
- 5. Keep important contacts including those for relatives/guardians, administration representatives in your wallet /purse.
- 6. Never venture out of your residences if it is late in the night unless under special circumstances. Students are advised not to venture out of their residences after 8.00pm.
- 7. Choose the company you keep carefully.
- 8. Always avoid venturing in areas already identified as crime prone.
- 9. Always be suspicious of strangers getting too much involved in your activities including taking gifts from them.
- 10. Avoid isolated places. Use routes/roads which are busy and well lit at night.
- 11. Avoid riparian areas especially during the rainy season due to swollen rivers.
- 12. Keep your valuable items in a lockable place. Avoid flaunting cash to avoid being marked.
- 13. Avoid walking on areas designated for vehicles/motor cycles.
- 14. Always listen to wise counsel, obey university college rules and regulations and above all obey all Kenyan laws.
- 15. Avoid overcrowded areas including social places where possible. Be ware of the possibility of your drink being laced with harmful substances in the social places.
- 16. Report suspicious persons/activities to the administration representative/police.
