ANNOUNCEMENT

MOROCCAN AGENCY OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION (AMCI) SCHOLARSHIP

The Ministry is in receipt of communication from the Embassy of the Kingdom of Morocco offering Government of the Republic of Kenya **Ten (10) scholarship slots for the 2023/2024 academic year**. The admitted students will take an initial French Language Course at a recognized French Language Centers in Kenya to harmoniously integrate their learning process of the academic year.

Interested candidates should have;

Undergraduate

- i. Minimum of KCSE Mean grade of B Plain
- ii. Less than 21 years though age limit for the candidates varies depending on the institution between 19 and 23 years.
- iii. Stronger grades in major subjects that are key to area of preferred specialty
- iv. Completed Secondary education in the last three years
- v. Have KCSE original certificate.

Masters

- i. Not more than 35 years old
- ii. Hold at least 2nd class Honours Upper Division Degree

PhD

- i. Not more than 45 years old
- ii. Hold a relevant Masters degree from a recognized University.

Application Form

Application forms are downloadable from AMCI website. For undergraduate, an indicative directory downloadable from the AMCI website through address www.amci.ma/publications the website has specific information on

list of Moroccan public higher education establishments such as conditions of access, courses, duration of studies etc.

For courses to be studied under Master's and Doctoral studies, candidates are requested to consult the Website of the Department of Higher Education: www.enssup.gov.ma as well as those of Moroccan Universities.

Cooperation Grant

The training grant is a maintenance grant. Its granting does not imply, in any case, the payment of registration fees, boarding school, transport or any other charges inherent in the pursuit of studies and which remain the responsibility of the student. The amount of scholarship is 750.00 dirhams (Approximately 75 US \$) per month, regardless of the cycle, the nature of the training and its duration. This amount may be subject to any deductions (University accommodation costs). The grant is paid for a period of 12 months per academic year (From September to August of the academic year in question). Training grant is paid bimonthly, in accordance with established schedule.

Accommodation

University accommodation is not granted automatically, however foreign students regularly registered with public higher education establishments may within the limits of available places, benefit from accommodation in boarding schools or university residences, subject to the payment of rental fees. Students wishing to benefit from this must file their applications with the AMCI.

Catering

University campuses have restaurants serving meals to the students within the limits of available places, meals for students at a single, subsidized rate. Students interested in this service are invited to contact the administration of these campuses to obtain university restaurant card.

Medical Cover

Foreign students are subscribed during their stay in Morocco to an insurance policy which offers the following benefits reimbursement of medical expenses, medical care, medical evacuation to the Country of origin in event of serious illness preventing the student from continuing his studies in Morocco and repatriation of the body in event of death on Moroccan territory. - ii. For undergraduate studies certified copies of KCSE Certificate,
- iii. For the post graduate studies certified copies of university degree, transcripts of the same,
- iv. Certified copies of the birth certificate and passport
- v. Certificate of good conduct.
- vi. A medical certificate issued by a public health services attesting to the physical fitness of the candidate and certifying one is vaccinated
