MOROCCAN AGENCY OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION (AMCI)

The Ministry is in receipt of communication from the Embassy of the Kingdom of Morocco in Nairobi informing that, the Kingdom of Morocco, through the Moroccan Agency of International Cooperation (AMCI), is offering to the Government of the Republic of Kenya a quota of **20** teaching places with scholarships for the academic year 2022/2023. These 20 places are part of the annual quota for Kenyan students wishing to continue their higher education in Morocco.

Successful applicants are invited to take initiation French language course at French language centers recognized, in Kenya, during the 2022-2023 academic year, to facilitate their smooth integration in the learning process of the academic year.

Interested candidate should have:

Undergraduate:

- Minimum KCSE mean Grade of B (plain).
- Less than 21 years for undergraduate.
- Strong grades in the major subject that are key to the preferred specialty.
- Completed Secondary Education in the last three (3) years.
- Has KCSE original certificate.

Masters:

- Not more than 25 years for Masters.
- Hold at least 2nd class Honors (Upper Division) degree.

PhD:

- Not more than 35 years.
- Hold a relevant Master's Degree from a recognized University.

Application forms are downloadable from the AMCI website through the address: www.amci.ma/publications all fields must be duly completed.

Accommodation.

University accommodation is not granted automatically. However, foreign students regularly registered with public higher education establishments may, within the limits of available places, benefit from accommodation in boarding schools or in university residences, subject to the payment of rental fees. Students wishing to benefit from it must submit their application to the AMCI.

Catering.

University campuses have a university restaurant serving meals for students at a single, subsidized rate. Students interested in this service are invited to contact the administration of these campuses to obtain university restaurant card.

Medical Cover.

Foreign students are subscribed, during their study stay in Morocco, to an Insurance Policy that offers the following: Reimbursement of medical cover, medical care, final sanitary evacuation to the country of origin, in case of serious illness and repatriation of the body in the event of death in the Moroccan territory. 1. Biography (CV) with a contact address, telephone number and email address.
2. **Candidates for basic studies:** original and certified copy of secondary school certificate.
3. **Candidate for master studies:** original and certified copy of the undergraduate degree certificates.
4. **Candidates for doctoral studies:** original and certified copy of the master's degree certificate.
5. A copy of the passport.
6. A photograph (passport)
7. Medical certificate issued by public services attesting to the physical fitness.
