1. Laboratory Technologist Grade 8

Duties and Responsibilities:

- a) Perform quality investigations and issue results which are accurate and reliable
- b) Maintain patient confidence by keeping laboratory information confidential
- c) Carry out quality control procedures in accordance with World Health Organization / Ministry of Health
- d) Ensure compliance to diagnostic protocols, quality assurance and control
- e) Ensure stock control and maintain accurate inventory
- f) Sterilize both laboratory equipment/appliances in line with the Ministry of Health regulations
- g) Provide information on suitability, reliability of laboratory reagents and equipment
- h) Maintain relevant records; prepare monthly reports, analyzing the trends of diseases
- i) Perform any other duties as may be assigned by the immediate supervisor.

Requirements;

- Bachelor's Degree in Medical Laboratory Science or equivalent qualification from a recognized institution
- Registered with Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians & Technologists Board
- Have a valid Practicing Licence
- Have three (3) years' relevant work experience in a level 4 hospital or a similar setting
